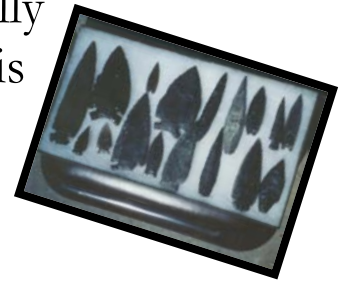
## Nevada Archaeological Association Archaeological Resource Protection Act (ARPA) Workshop
